RE: CANDIDATE'S STATEMENT

WHEREAS, Section 10012 of the Elections Code of the State of California requires this Board to adopt certain policies in regard to candidates' statements for candidates who run for office of member of the Board of Directors of the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Directors does hereby determine, as follows:

- that the cost of printing, handling and mailing a candidate's statement shall be paid by (2) the candidate;
- that candidates not be permitted to submit additional materials to be sent to the voter with the sample ballot;
- that the statement shall not exceed (3) 200 words;
- that the Registrar of Voters be directed to give a copy of these regulations to each candidate or his/her representative at the time he/she picks up his/her nomination documents;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these policies shall remain in full force and effect until rescinded by this Board.
