CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) AND YOUR DRINKING WATER

Your drinking water is safe and will remain available during this pandemic. The CDC reports that the COVID-19 virus has not been detected in drinking water¹ and the filtration and disinfection methods used by Vandenberg Village Community Services District (VVCSD) are sufficient to disinfect water for contaminants, including COVID-19. Our groundwater wells would not be sources for COVID-19 and testing throughout our distribution system ensures a chlorine residual so water is clean and safe for consumption.
